



## A new way of Phone Conferencing

Have you ever wondered how we can better serve our customers when they ask for a polycom speaker phone especially when there are more than ten people in a room which will not accommodate both the sound and audio levels being heard by the receiving party on the other line of the phone? Now there is a more productive and professional way of meeting and exceeding the customer's expectations of a successful audio teleconference. I would like to introduce the Telos One Digital Phone Hybrid Interface.

If there is a conference with more than 20 people, a telephone hybrid can be connected to a 16-channel mixing board (required) so that all the hand held wireless microphones that are required would be channeled through the hybrid and that the receiving end (caller's phone outside the hotel) would be able to communicate with the speaker and the audience. The internal ballroom speakers would be the excellent applications for monitor output for the audience to hear the incoming caller and/or presenter.

The audiovisual equipment required in order to meet and exceed the customer's expectations are the following for an audio teleconference:

- Digital Telephone Interface: \$225
- 16 Channel Mixer (Powered): \$125
- Handheld Wireless Microphones for Presenter, and Audience for Q & A (numbers of microphones may increase due to size of audience participation). Usually four wireless microphones are recommended for more than 100 audience members (One Wireless Handheld for the presenter and three for the audience). \$150 each
- Standard Telephone for connection
- AV Technician during event to monitor audio line inputs and outputs during teleconference: \$600 full day rate
